Time Commitment for the Multi Media-Yearbook Elective

This is the area that occasionally causes miscommunication. There is no doubt that participating in yearbook is very time-consuming. Here are some points to consider:

- A yearbook staff member is expected to attend sporting and middle school events such as games, fun nights, choir or band concerts, plays, service projects and in school activities. These games and events usually take place after school.
- Other than attending sporting and middle school events after school, the amount of time a staffer spends outside of class is directly related to how effectively he/she uses class time and how able he/she is at deciding what to do when, being able to quickly change directions if one task becomes temporarily undoable.
- A student can do some work at home if he/she has been diligent about collecting information at school. At home, students can organize notes, think of leads or stories, write scripts, log in and work on his/her yearbook page(s), edit photos and upload them to the website. Doing this will vastly decrease the time at school.
